Justin D. Pitt serves as President and Chief Legal and Administrative Officer and Assistant Secretary. In this role, he has leadership responsibility for our legal function and services, strategy and operational

alignment, government relations, risk management including enterprise risk management, human resources and governance. Mr. Pitt joined us in 2009 as Litigation Counsel after several years of private practice as a litigator and lobbyist to the Tennessee General Assembly. In 2017, he was promoted to Senior Vice President and Chief Litigation Counsel. In that role, he served as our primary counsel for litigation, managed care, reimbursement and other legal matters and also oversaw the operations of the legal and government relations departments. He was promoted to Executive Vice President and General Counsel in 2022 and to President and Chief Legal and Administrative Officer in February 2025. Mr. Pitt serves as a member of the American Health Lawyers Association and as member of the board of governors of the Federation of American Hospitals. He is a fellow of the Nashville Health Care Council and a member of the Leaders Council of the Legal Services Corporation, the largest funder of civil legal aid for low income Americans in the United States. Mr. Pitt is also a member of the board of trustees of Cumberland University in Lebanon, Tennessee. He received his law degree, Order of the Coif, from Washington University School of Law, where he was a William Webster Fellow.
